

OMTG - Membership

Anyone interested in the design and construction of optical instruments and systems may join the Optomechanical/Instrument Technical Group (OMTG). There are no qualifications other than the member's own interest in the art of optomechanics and there are no fees for membership.

The principal activities of the Group are an annual evening meeting with a speaker followed by an open-forum "Problems and Solutions Workshop" and a biennial technical conference of 35 to 50 technical papers. Both activities occur during SPIE's Optics and Photonics Symposium during the summer months, usually in August and usually in San Diego, California.
